According to our treasurer's analysis, this location is centrally located for our current membership.

The rate charged by the new venue lowers our costs per dance. Therefore, your board is currently assessing our income and expenses to determine changes to annual dues and dance fees that will keep the club's finances healthy for the future, including building a suitable reserve for unforeseen expenses.
